
WWI & WWII MEMORIAL INSCRIPTIONS IN LUDDENDEN CEMETERY

Several further inscriptions may exist, currently obscured by wear, collapse of the stone, algae or vegetation. However, a reasonable estimate would be that 10% or less of the stones were unseen.


William Henry Tolley William Henry Tolley, killed in action 3rd April 1918.

9 Thomas WADSWORTH



John Faulkes killed in action March 28th 1918.







Albert killed in action North Africa 1942.






18 John Oscar & Albert Louis THOMPSON
