New Agricultural building at Dean House Farm, 18/00710/FUL 3 August

Single storey extension to side and rear, 18 New Road (*ex school caretaker's house*) 18/00755/HSE 3 August

Replace UPVC windows and doors with hardwood conservation windows and doors Delph House, Delph Hill Lane 18/00785/ LBC, 3 August

Replace existing conservatory with single storey lean-to and windows to South West elevation 18/00751/HSE Jack Cottage, 1A Bluebell Walk 17 August

WORLD WAR 1 COMMEMORATIONS



During August, there is just one commemoration, bringing the total number of men commemorated to 35 out of the 45 named on the memorial.

Private Willie Uttley lived at Far Broadfold and had worked as a quarryman. He was conscripted in 1916 and was with the East Lancashire Regiment. He died aged 33 on 23 August 1918, and is buried in Bailleul, France. Willie had attended Booth Chapel. Do join us at the cenotaph at noon on Thursday 23rd August if you are able to.
